

## Injured woman celebrates deck's completion

Friends and family of Judy Aguirre, a Baldwinsville mother who was severely injured in an accident at her home last September, will celebrate today the completion of a wheelchair-accessible deck.

McClurg Remodeling and Construction Services, of Marcellus, led the community-wide effort by building the deck off Aguirre's home on North Brickyard Road. McClurg employees volunteered their time to complete the project.

Aguirre, 44, fell down her basement stairs on Sept. 26, suffering an incomplete spinal cord injury. After 13 weeks in the hospital, she receives physical therapy at home and is regaining some movement in her feet and legs.

The wheelchair-accessible deck will support Aguirre's therapy and enable her to enjoy family life with her husband and two young sons. The project began May 19. Donations were provided by 13 local businesses.
